


Button Lock

Rear Carrier Adaptor for PakRak Bags

For mounting Pakrak trunk bags.



Tools Required: 3 mm Allen key, Ruler or tape measure.

Parts

- a | Allen bolts x 4
- b Washers x 4
- c Front beam
- e Clamp bases x 4
- f Clamp hooks (with nuts) x 4


Most seatpost-mounted and frame-mounted carriers. Width adjustable: 90–140 mm (measured from centreline of carrier rails). Carrier Rail Diameter Range: 9–12.7 mm. Bag Compatibility

PakRak Commuter Bags (carrier needs min. of 265 mm of level rail length). Mini Commuter Bags.

INSTALLATION

Cargo tray rails


- 1. Install front beam: Attach washers to bolts. With narrow end of front beam facing front of carrier, place a bolt through left slot. Attach a clamp base underneath beam (flat side up, bevelled end facing out). Seat beam at front of carrier with clamp base on left carrier rail, then attach a clamp hook underneath, facing out.* Screw in bolt loosely to attach clamp. Repeat these steps for right side of beam. Repeat above process for rear beam, this time with narrow end facing rear (see fig. 1, fig. 2).
- 2. Position beams to fit your bag by measuring distance between front and rear beams: 205 mm for Commuter Bags; 120 mm for Mini Commuter Bags. Both beams should be aligned and centred (left to right) on carrier (see fig. 3). Tighten all bolts securely.



MOUNTING BAG

Pakrak bags use a clip-on mechanism with a release button.

1. Align attachment 'lip' on front of bag with rounded arch on front beam (see fig. 4). 2. Lock bag onto carrier by pushing down on rear of bag, while pressing in button. 3. To detach bag, press release button, and lift from carrier (see fig. 5). 4. If bag does not fit firmly when mounted and release easily when detached, adjust position of beams.
